This strategic move, which has been two years in the planning, was a conscious decision made by the head teachers and governors, aimed at protecting and enhancing the quality of the educational provision in our schools. The other members of the Trust are Wolgarston High School, Penkrigde Middle School, Marshbrook First School and St John's First School. We have already been working closely together as a federation and academisation will enable us to continue to develop this, to support each other, share good practice and subject expertise, pool resources, as well as benefitting financially through joint economies of scale in areas such as purchasing and efficiencies gained through the use of a central business team. The names of our schools will remain the same and we will continue to be committed to improving teaching and learning and providing a high quality, cohesive education for all our pupils from age 2 -19.
