- Lunchtime supervisor designated to support with behaviour and well being
- After school Club – designated to help integrate pupils new to the school
- Music Tuition and attendance at Extra Curricular Clubs such as French, Chess & dance club
- Attendance to specific curricular activities – Wildwood Experience, Music and Art workshop
