Thank you for your co-operation during the unplanned recent fire alarm, however, it proved to be a useful exercise should this happen again at the start or end of the day. Please note that in future: 1. Parents should stay with their child where possible, if unable to do so they please make the class teacher aware that you are leaving. 2. ALL children (including children not yet at school) to remain in their class line with parents that are staying, standing alongside class lines (not on grassed areas). Younger children should not be allowed to run around as they need to be accounted for at all times. 3. Remain on the playground and do not access Bike Sheds or Nursery/ Reception playground. The safety of all children and adults is our priority and we appreciate your ongoing support.
